Swimming Reminders

We are very excited to commence swimming lessons for all children after half term. Please be reminded of the following swimming kit:

- Swimming costume (no bikinis)/ swimming trunks (no loose, Bermuda-style swimming shorts please)
- Towel (named)
- Swimming hat (named)
- Crocs/ flip flops (to wear from the changing room to the poolside—named)
- No jewellery will be allowed to be worn in the pool. Please remove children's earrings in the morning.

Children from Year 2 upwards are now permitted to wear goggles for their school swimming lessons, if they wish to, as long as your child can put them on and take them off totally independently and safely without adult support (adults will not be able to adjust fitting or positioning). If goggles are worn, they must be labelled in a waterproof pen and cannot be shared between children. Please note that if goggles are causing any child discomfort or difficulties during a lesson, the teacher will ask for them to be taken off for the remainder of the lesson.
