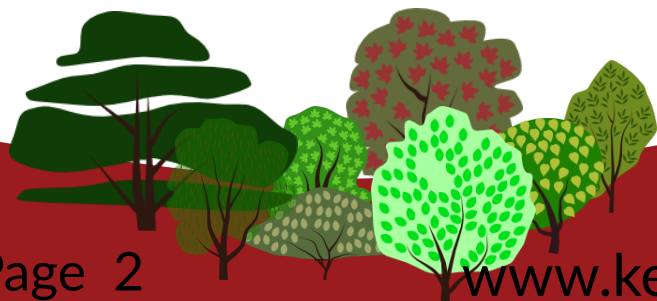
Celebration Assembly Special Mentions
