### **Bikes/Scooters**

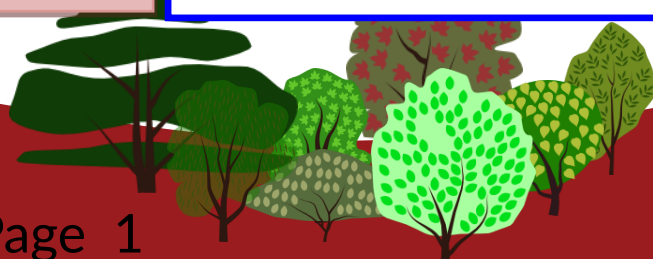
