### Hot weather alert

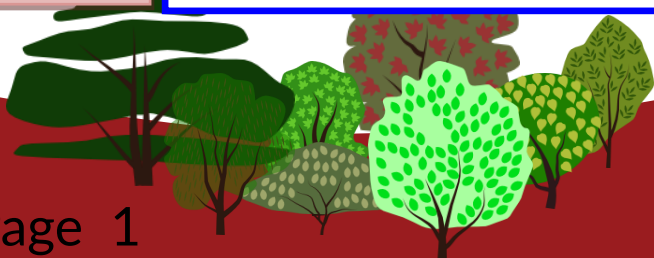
