PA Mother's Day Gifts - Tuesday 14th March

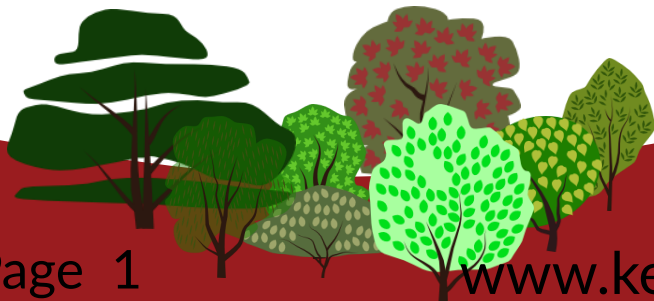
On Tuesday next week, the children can bring £2 in a named purse or envelope to purchase a gift for their Mum, family member or friend.
